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**Expert comparative analysis of the causes of political crisis / crisis  
methodology of political science**

***Abstract.** Comparative analysis of the causes of the political crisis in Ukraine in the XXI century, based on a study Ukrainian geocentric factor of the global crisis on the basis of the author's methodology post-academism, in conjunction with expert technique of «feedback». Analysis of the content and titles of political science articles published in the Ukrainian scientific journals and scientific collections revealed the lack of studies and publications on the topics of «Ukrainian political crisis» and «causes of the Ukrainian political crisis.» So, the analysis of the titles of 170 political science articles published in the anthology «Grani» in 2004-2007., Showed no articles on these topics. And in the journal «Viche» in 2007 and in 2014 there also were no articles on these topics. At the same time in the journals in other scientific journals and scientific collections there are articles on «orange revolution» and «revolution of dignity». This political science nonsense when we study the revolution and analyze the causes of political crisis caused by the revolution.*

***Key words:** post-academism methodology, the global crisis, Ukrainian political crisis.*

Formulation of the problem in general terms. Analysis of the content and titles of political articles published in the Ukrainian scientific journals and scientific collections, revealed the lack of studies and publications on the topics of "Ukrainian political crisis" and "the causes of the Ukrainian political crisis."

The most objectively, comprehensively and systematically highlights the causes of the political crisis of 2004-2007 on the basis of peer review social scientists, including

those from the analyzed 23 indicators identified five of the most important factors and causes (performance) of the political crisis, that are ranked in descending order of significance [8, p.17]:

I - artificial political crisis caused by the ruling political regime to divert attention from addressing pressing social, political and economic problems.

II - Combating major industrial and financial groups for political power. And the political parties in this fight in the role of tools.

III - The underdevelopment of democracy and civil society, political domination, social, psychological and value-regulatory systems and traditions of post-communism.

IV - The inaction of parliament for maximum profit basic IFG, as there is no public and parliamentary control over the activity of big business and the major IFG.

V - The actions of external forces on the list of Ukraine (including the "Yugoslav scenario").

The purpose of research - an empirical, comparative and methodological analysis of the causes of the political crisis in Ukraine on the basis of the author's fact-and the author's theoretical and methodological studies, on the basis of Ukrainian geocentric factor of world wars, in conjunction with the global and European crises and its modern method of expert assessment of the causes of the political crisis.

Over the past 9 years, a considerable number of empirical studies of individual historical stages of the pre-crisis [9; 10] and the crisis [11; 8; 12] the state of Ukrainian politics, causes and consequences of the I World War II [13], "outstanding" role of the Ukrainian Social-Democrats and the Bolsheviks forced the modernization of the Ukrainian nation [14; 15], the reasons for the Orthodox people of Ukraine of genocide and destruction of highly moral Christian worldview by civil war, man-made famines and on the basis of the forcible imposition of (cloning) soviet communist ideology [16; 17].

In the course of empirical research and piloting pre-crisis state of the Ukrainian society in the twentieth century. was found a huge unexplored scientific problem (and research topic), representing not only one of the possible prehistory and prerequisites of modern political crises in Ukraine, but also is a «terra incognita» for the Ukrainian

political scientists and researchers of the Ukrainian political history: why and therefore the Ukrainian people were given the historical fate of such a huge humanitarian disaster and ethnic genocide, why Ukraine was the epicenter of the world wars, famines and genocide of Orthodox peoples, including why Ukraine suffered the greatest loss of life in the history of the world in the I half of the twentieth century., which killed more than 21 million Ukrainians - more than any country in the world during this period [12, p.71]. The reasons for this above a humanitarian disaster and ethnic genocide have not disappeared in the last century, as today, on the territory of Ukraine, on the basis of the ongoing global crisis, and as a result of the Ukrainian political crisis, continued permanent World War. The reason for this war was the winter revolution, armed seizure of Russia Crimea and separatist armed uprisings in Eastern Ukraine.

And one of the deeper causes of the war, according to our hypothesis, are the claims of neighboring states on natural resources and the territory of Ukraine. War, which received the code name «Proxy war» and carried out by proxy on foreign territory - this is a war between the two most powerful military and industrial power in the world in the territory of Ukraine. When fully captured the Crimea, destroyed cities like Slavyansk and being destroyed Slavs, resettled from Russia to Ukraine after the Holodomor for the industrialization of the country, and after World War II to rebuild the destroyed industry. And the beginning of a new phase of the permanent World War III in the Ukraine served as an information attack on the television viewers around the world, showing live footage disperse a student demonstration in Kiev of 11/30/14.

For a more detailed and objective investigation of the above hypotheses and data from previous empirical and flight research we have developed a two-tier rational method of expert evaluation of "feedback" when the feedback in the study of the above problems and hypotheses are expert opinion Dnepropetrovsk political scientists about possible causes and factors of the global crisis and it modern political crises in Ukraine, studied on two levels of historical comparative: I - at the level of defining the world and Ukrainian historical events and twentieth artifacts that are WHO can be profound historical background of the Ukrainian crisis of the XXI in, and II level - at the level it modern economic,.. political, religious, social and ethnic and national Ukrainian and

international problems, causes and factors (the study as "indicators"), determine the development of Ukrainian political crisis in winter 2013-2014. and in the spring of 2014.

As an expert assessment of the causes of political crisis in Ukraine and the development of scientific methods and peer review questionnaire and was conducted with the help of historians and political scientists Dnepropetrovsk. Firstly, to develop methods and indicators has been used as much as possible the experience and achievements of the first aerobic expert evaluation (in 2008) the causes of the first political crisis of 2004-2007., Where experts made 12 social scientists Dnepropetrovsk [8, p.17] . Second, the development of the basic concepts and the two-level indicators of rational methods of expert assessments of the causes of the political crisis of 2013-2014. We took an active part, and the experts themselves (A. Nikhilev).

The most important historical background (indicators) of modern Ukrainian political crisis, according Dnepropetrovsk experts are 7 of the most significant indicators (39% of the total of 18 indicators), who took the first 7 ranks in order of importance (and 49% of total points): I and II ranks occupied indicators "The collapse of the Soviet Union and the revival of the Ukrainian state-OPERATION" and simultaneous "Revival in the 90 years of the twentieth century of Ukrainian post-Soviet oligarchy of officials and criminal workers that were assigned to industries and natural resources, and the result is a huge excess profits at the expense of the actual appropriation of the natural rent and brutal exploitation of workers receiving minimum wages most in Europe". III rank occupied index "Ukrainian state independence period (1991-2013) - crisis caused by constant political crises, interethnic fights and deteriorating socio-economic situation of the Ukrainian people". At the IV place - "The low level of consolidation of the Ukrainian people, the low level of democratic maturity of the Ukrainian society and ideological disunity of the Ukrainian government in 1918-1919". And V and VI areas - the Holodomor of 1932-1933, as well as the total destruction of religion and genocide. Orthodox people of Ukraine. At the VII place experts put the "Bloody madness in the history of Ukraine in 1914-1945, when Ukraine

became a geopolitical center of the world wars and the center cannibal Bolshevik experiment and repression that led to the deaths of 20 million Ukrainians”.

An important element of our two-level methods of rational expert evaluation is the use of rational, that is, quantitative traits, characteristics and indicators, with a view to transforming the quality (irrational) indicators and signs of political processes in comparable (to each other) quantitative indicators. Since about 90% of political and historical publications are not comparable because of the large number of quality indicators [11, c. 9].

In our expert assessment of 42 variants of the causes and factors (indicators) of the political crisis of 2013-2014, the most significant are:

I rank (7.88 points) - "Lack of talent, hypocritical and sales Ukrainian post-Soviet elite, who failed in 22 years of independence Ukrainian democracy and create an effective public administration. And this elite desperately held at the public trough and does not allow the authorities to young and effective managers. "

II rank (score 7.55) - "The discontent of the people of the ruling totalitarian regime, the highest in Europe the level of corruption and the dependence of judges."

III rank (score 7.24) - "The increase corporatocracy, including corrupt communication of business and government, when Ukrainian oligarchs in order to maximize profits embedded in the supreme power in the management of ministries and regions."

IV grade (7.18 points) - "An unfocused, inconsistent, contradictory, anti-people and falsely-populist foreign and domestic policy of the Ukrainian authorities in 2012-2013."

V Rank (7.12 points) - "economic reasons. People who came to the Maidan, eager to change the economic model of the state, which is now for the majority - is unpromising. Which gives most workers meager wages and huge profits Ukrainian oligarchs because of the over-exploitation of natural resources, which are public property. And oligarchs are actually appropriated the natural rent, which today is six times less than the possible composition of the rental income of the state budget. "

VI grade (6.85 points) - "Final stagnation corrupt political regime, the absence of a national patriotic ideas that can unite East and West of Ukraine."

VII grade (6.52 points) - "Strengthening the geopolitical struggle for territory and resources of Ukraine from the EU, US and Russia."

VIII grade (6.48 points) - "Tough totalitarian vertical and over-centralization of presidential power, the lack of reform of local government and self-financing."

Ninth grade (6.42 points) - "The revolution has arisen spontaneously, on a wave of popular indignation police arbitrariness, including beating the Democrats at the Independence Square in Kiev, on the night of November 30, 2013".

X Rank (6.27 points) - "Russia's economic pressure on Ukraine, which led to the failure of the signing of the agreement on association of Ukraine with the EU and to a large-scale clashes."

We propose to discuss the new methodology for post-academic, which allows not only to explain the historical and political science logic driving political forces in world history of modern times, the world, European and Ukrainian political crises, but also the relationship of world wars with Ukrainian geocentric factor with the greatest global humanitarian disaster on Ukraine in the twentieth century.

Author's post-academic methodology of political science knowledge also includes five new, interconnected, Political conceptual guidelines:

A. The main reason for the world, European and Ukrainian political crisis is not only the struggle of the industrialized countries for new natural resources and territory by the world wars, but also the communist and post-communist ideas and the revolution, which by the middle of the twentieth century. It led to the creation of totalitarian communist regimes in large parts of the globe.

B. The main cause of the economic world wars is a Ukrainian geocentric factor of natural resources, as one of the major political, religious and atheistic consequences of the global political crisis, world and civil wars were the cultural suicide, religious genocide and ethnic genocide, including those due to political and religious war with the Orthodox Church, the Ukrainian Orthodox people. This war ended with the death of the Ukrainian Orthodox civilization, homeland and center in the Dnieper Ukraine.

Degeneration of the titular Ukrainian Orthodox nation and led to the loss of Ukrainian national identity. This concept is the world's political crisis and its mirror image Ukrainian justified huge amount of Ukrainian Orthodox people victims of the twentieth century.

C. The object of the post-academic political history are not only political power, political institutions and political regimes, but also political implications and humanitarian catastrophe as a result of the struggle of the totalitarian political regime against its own people, including atheistic titular ethnic genocide of Orthodox nations causing numerous victims of civil wars, political repression and atheistic.

D. A critical component of the global political crisis and the permanent World War III is not only a "hybrid" and local wars, but also an information war, which is conducted by two (three), the world's most powerful military-industrial groups of countries on the territory of the weakest countries in the world III rich natural resources (Iraq, Libya, Nigeria, Syria, Somalia and Ukraine).

E. It is equally important component of the political system and political power in crisis (or crises) countries with a totalitarian regime ruling is hypocritical and corrupt elite. Which helps to transform the country from a subject into an object of geopolitical struggle, the object of the world's political crisis and the permanent World War III.

Conclusions. Political processes in it modern world should be measured not only by the level of development of democracy or totalitarianism. But the volume of human victims, laid on the altar of political science. Since nothing is more precious than human life and there is nothing more cynical - eye closure to a tragic political history of Ukraine.

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
