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Theory of postacademism prediction strategy in Ukrainian politics (2017–2037 biennium).

Since 2003, the Ukrainian political science and political history and political science notes the high vacuum of empirical and theoretical-methodological research, analyzing the key features and marks the transformation of Ukrainian politicians, including there is a lack of studies on deep historical and geopolitical roots of Ukrainian political crises of 2004–2007, in 2013–2014, military conflict in the east of Ukraine in 2014–2016, respectively. The lack of such research is not it allows you to define the main vector of the current and future transformation of Ukrainian politicians and Ukrainian political system. In this regard we have been conducted empirical studies on the main characteristics and transformation markers Ukrainian politics, which served as the basis for the theory of the author and the author's methodology post-academism Forecasting Ukrainian politicians in the 2017–2037.

Conceptual apparatus of research methodology and research tools – in accordance with the author's methodology of political science categorically been developed. Including five major research categories, reflecting the complex predictive analysis of the key markers of the future of Ukrainian politicians on the basis of three-pronged approach multivariate “past-present-future” for cyclical and epistemological relationship of past and future national and geo-strategic priorities have been identified: A. Historical and socio cultural changes in the process of Ukrainian national identity in the modern history of Ukraine. B. Role of Ukrainian economic and natural potential in the tragic Ukrainian history of modern times. C. Internal political prognostic markers Ukrainian politicians. D. Geopolitical prognostic markers Ukrainian politicians. E. Geo-economic prognostic markers Ukrainian politicians.

These five basic research categories in its integrated and interconnected essentially reflect our categorical and conceptual apparatus of the study of the future of the Ukrainian political and epistemological content of the concept "Future Ukrainian politicians." In view of the novelty of the introduction of the scientific revolution in

political science and political science subjects and the basic concepts of strategic forecasting Ukrainian politics for the followers of this subject for scientific expertise derived prognostic studies more important than the results (for example, the main vector polit-forecasts), is a scientific apparatus research including support methodological paradigm, method and research instrumentary.

In accordance with the above methodological hypothesis and the main object of the study was developed political science categorial-conceptual apparatus of the study. Including identified five main categories of research, reflecting the complex predictive analysis of the key markers of the future of Ukrainian politicians on the basis of three-pronged approach Multivariate "past-present-future" for cyclical and epistemological relationship of past and future national and geostrategic priorities.

A. The historical and socio-cultural process of change in Ukrainian national identity in the modern history of Ukraine.

B. Role of Ukrainian economic and natural potential in the tragic Ukrainian history of modern times.

V. Internal political prognostic markers Ukrainian politicians.

G. Geopolitical prognostic markers Ukrainian politicians.

D. Geo-economic prognostic markers Ukrainian politicians.

These five basic research categories in its complex essence reflect our categorial and conceptual apparatus of the study of the future of the Ukrainian political and epistemological content of the concept "Future Ukrainian politicians." This integrated approach will allow not only to objectively substantiate the forecast of the main vector of development of the future of Ukrainian politicians on the basis of three-pronged approach Multivariate "past-present-future", but also to reveal the relationship of domestic and geopolitical categories in the future Ukrainian politics. Including reasonable answer to the question, there is a military conflict in the East of Ukraine today (and in the near future) - it is a common civil war (on ethno-national or religious grounds), or is the military aggression of the Russian Federation (RF) against Ukraine or is it a third world hybrid war between Russia and the United States on the territory of Ukraine?

In our study, the epistemological relationship analysis of internal political, geopolitical and geo-economic categories (and markers), in the framework of the "past-present-future", was held in the first phase in the four directions of empirical research:

I. Identification of the defining events in the modern history of Ukrainian in the XX and XXI centuries [6], [7], [8].

II. Identification of the main markers and characteristics of Ukrainian national identity in recent history [9], [10].

III. Identify the underlying causes and factors of Ukrainian political crises in the twenty-first century [11], [12], [13].

IV. Identification markers in personalistic Ukrainian political history of the twentieth century [14].

Development of author's methodology for post-academic also contributed to the accumulated experience since 2003, methodological and empirical studies of the main characteristics of the transformation of Ukrainian politics, which allowed for the first time to approach this scientific problem and formulate the first pilot study methodological principles of political science research in the study of the causes of the Ukrainian political crisis of 2004 - 2007 [19]. And also for the first time and put into scientific circulation the concept of "Ukrainian politicians" on the basis of research into the causes of the Ukrainian political crisis and to identify the main characteristics of the transformation of the Ukrainian political system [20].

The above theoretical, methodological and empirical studies, including the author's methodology post-academism, and were also used in the development of methods and tools of the first piloting predictive studies [21]. This study indicates that the main political analysts forecast the future of Ukrainian politics is a militarized version - a third world war is a hybrid between the Russian Federation and the United States on the territory of Ukraine. When the Ukrainian internal political forces and the US are interested in further retraction of Russia in the war with the aim of further economic and political weakening of the Russian Federation as a result of economic and political sanctions of Western countries against Russia.

Conclusions. In view of the novelty of the introduction of the scientific revolution in political science and political science subjects and the basic concepts of strategic forecasting Ukrainian politics for the followers of this subject, as well as for scientific expertise derived prognostic studies more important than the results (eg, the above-mentioned paramilitary vector political forecasts and the disintegration of the Russian Federation) is a scientific research unit, including support methodological paradigm, methodology and research tools. As the only approved and appropriate for the Ukrainian reality, forecasting methodologies, techniques and research tools will help not only to identify the main vector of development of Ukrainian politics for the next 20 years, but also to sustain and adequately reflect the impartial scientific examination and criticism of scientific experts.
